



Admissions Policy

It is our intention to make our setting accessible to children and families from all sections of the local community. We aim to ensure that all sections of our community have access to the setting through open, fair and clearly communicated procedures.

We make Rainbow accessible to all families regardless of gender, special educational needs, disabilities, social background, religion or ethnicity.

Accepting children from the ages of 2 years until 4 years.

Children are placed on a waiting list and places are offered two terms in advance with priority for siblings, then on a first come first served basis from the waiting list.

Once a definite place is offered a non-refundable deposit is required to confirm the place.

The term before your child starts Rainbow you are both invited to join us for a morning / afternoon play date at Rainbow to meet the staff, be introduced to your child's Key Person and have time to play.

We have a staggered start for new children and liaise closely with their parent on the best way for their child to settle into the group. Each child has a designated 'key person' who looks after the child's personal, social and emotional development; however any member of staff may be approached with any questions.
